Jason Windows offer fibreglass mesh in our flyscreens as standard. However, your clients have the option to upgrade the type of flyscreen mesh depending on their needs. It's important to note, flyscreens are just that, screens to prevent flies and other insects entering the home. If your client requires screens to help keep their children and pets on the safe side, then we recommend upgrading to either perforated or stainless steel security screens.



FLYSCREENS

Frames

Jason doors and windows are designed to accept a standard flyscreen covering the opening and preventing the intrusion of unwanted insects. Jason flyscreens are manufactured using a sturdy extruded aluminium section rather than with lightweight roll form material to provide extra strength. The screens fit flush in the frame with easy installation and removal for cleaning.

Hardware

Flydoors are light weight and can easily blow open on a windy day. All Jason flydoors come with a metal door latch to prevent this.

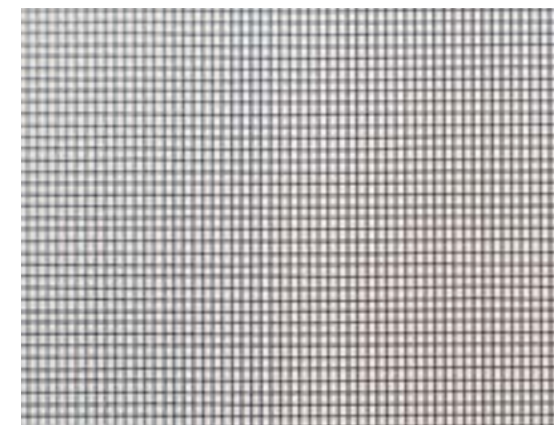


Fibreglass Mesh

Fibreglass Mesh is supplied as standard and is suitable for keeping most insects out of the home.

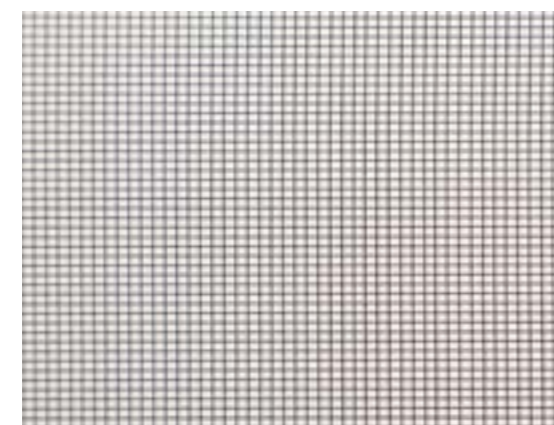


Aluminium Mesh

Powder coated aluminium mesh offering better durability than fibreglass insect mesh. Aluminium Mesh is non-flammable, fire resistant and complies with AS3959 up to BAL29.

- Excellent visibility

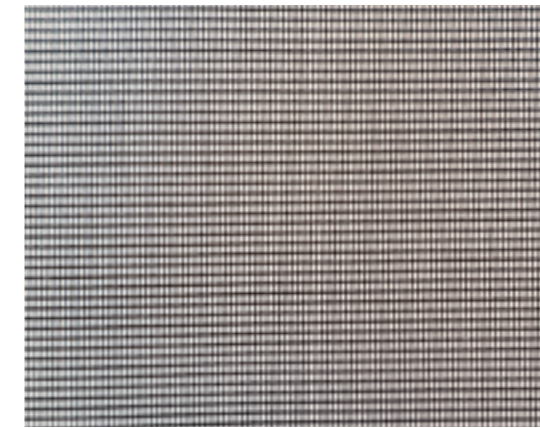


Steel Mesh

Steel Mesh is stronger than Aluminium Mesh and offers good resistance to corrosion. Steel mesh is non-flammable, fire resistant and complies with AS3959 up to BAL29.

Migi Mesh

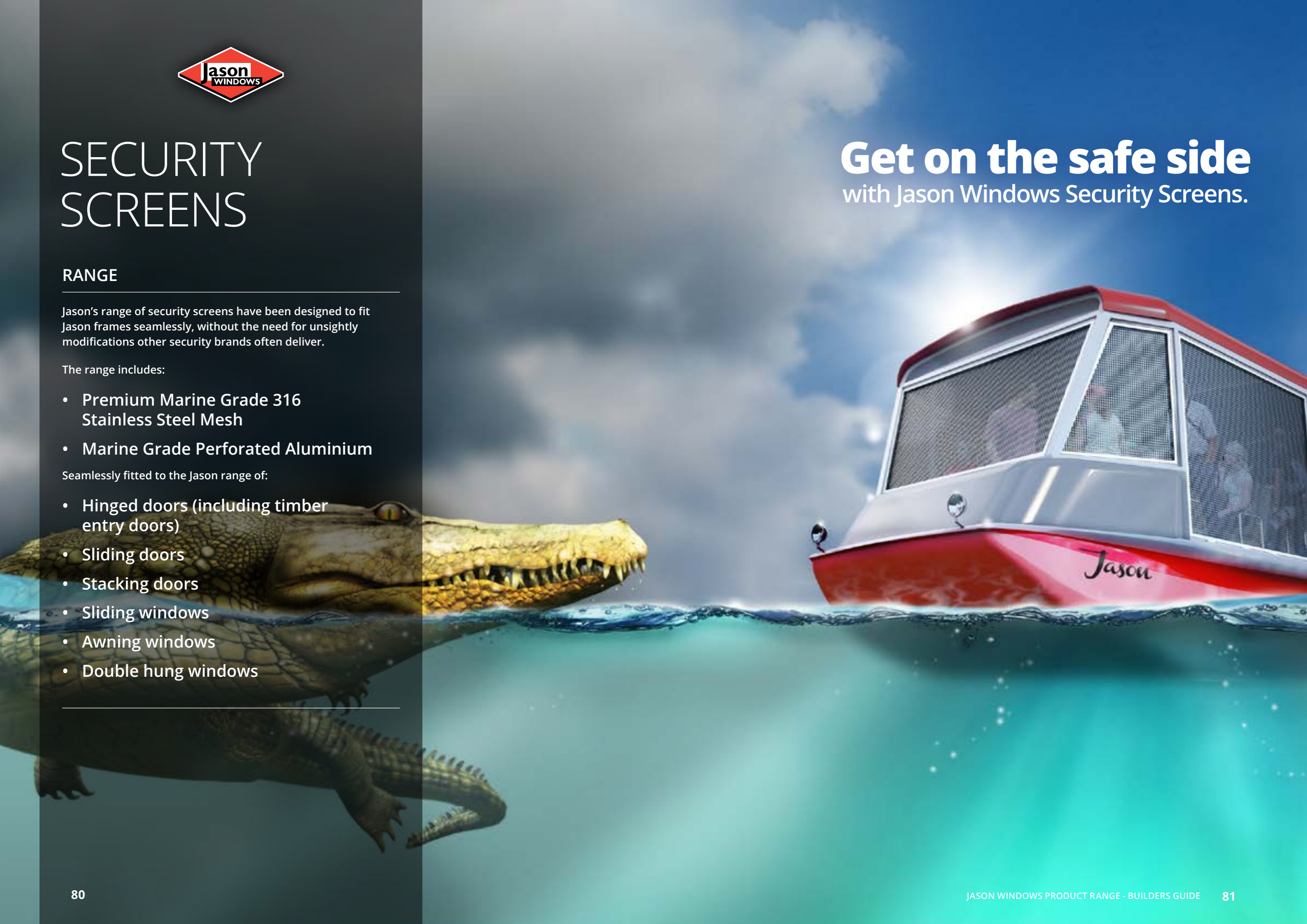

Strength & Assurance

316 MARINE GRADE STAINLESS STEEL MESH

Jason premium security screens are made from 316 marine grade stainless steel woven mesh for ultimate security. The woven mesh is retained in the frame using a UV resistant PVC co-extrusion to provide the highest level of corrosion resistance available.



PERFORATED MARINE GRADE ALUMINIUM

The Jason perforated range of security screens are constructed from a single sheet of tempered marine grade perforated aluminium and retained in the frame using a unique bonding process for extra strength.



Triple Lock, One Flick System

All Jason security screen doors have a triple lock, one flick system. With one flick, three locking points are activated on the door providing extra protection from the door being wrenched at the top or bottom by an intruder. All hinged doors have three fixed pin hinges that cannot be removed.

BAL Fire Rated

The Jason range of 316 and perforated Security Screens meet bush fire ratings up to and including BAL29.

Kids Can't Fly

In 2013 the Australian Building Code ruled that some upper level windows require opening restrictors to prevent the window being opened more than 125mm. This was introduced in an effort to prevent the growing number of children falling from double storey homes. All Jason security screens meet the building code requirements for upper storey windows without having to restrict their opening to 100mm.

There's a clear difference with Jason Windows security screens. In addition to the standard security screen features offered by most suppliers, Jason security screens have a range of unique features.
